WITNESS THE BLOOM OF THE LOTUS CLASS

Inspired by the gentle beauty of the lotus and the warmth of caring hearts, this edition celebrates a season filled with kindness, connections, and discovering the joy of growing together.

As chilly days softened and spring began to bloom, the Lotus class explored our themes in action through songs, storytelling, imaginative play, group activities, and hands-on discoveries.

January

During this month, our preschoolers have been exploring the theme of kindness and what it means to be a caring friend. Through group discussions, stories, and everyday interactions, children practiced using kind words, gentle hands, and calm bodies. We talked about how our actions can make others feel happy, safe, and included. We noticed many special moments of kindness—friends offering a toy, giving a hug, or using polite words like “please” and “thank you.” We also practiced recognizing our feelings and using calm strategies, such as taking deep breaths, when big emotions arise.



February

This month, we focused on celebrating love, friendship, and connection within our classroom community. The children enjoyed expressing care for one another through a variety of creative activities. They made colorful Valentine’s cards for friends and family, thoughtfully choosing decorations and sharing kind messages.

March

We explored the wonders of spring by learning how plants grow and what they need to thrive. The children created 3D flower art and practiced math by counting seeds and digging for bugs in sensory play. We also learned about spring insects; a special highlight was receiving our live caterpillars, which we are observing as they grow and transform into butterflies.

January

We kicked off the new year with exciting bubble parties! The children enjoyed chasing, popping, and watching bubbles float through the air. This activity encouraged movement, coordination, and lots of joyful laughter as they explored cause and effect in a playful way. This experience also sparked curiosity, as children explored cause and effect—discovering what happens when they blow gently, wave their hands, or try to catch a bubble before it pops. The activity encouraged social interaction as well, with children being able to enjoy the experience together.



February

In February, we focused on spreading love and kindness through various Valentine's themed art projects. One in particular was our hot air balloon activity. The children participated in decorating their own balloons, expressing creativity while learning about shapes, colors, and the theme of love and friendship.

March

This month, we celebrated St. Patrick's Day with a hands-on art activity. The children glued small pieces of green construction paper onto a shamrock outline. With teacher support, glue was initially applied; however, many children showed curiosity and began independently brushing the glue onto the paper. We love seeing their confidence build and fine motor skills improve!
